


How long have you been in the neighborhood?







## How do you typically get around the neighborhood?










What barriers keep you from accessing services offered by GHA?






81% of respondents would like new housing to be located in the **Pine Meadows** / Lake Terrace area or another part of East Gainesville




If Pine Meadows or Lake Terrace are redeveloped, would you prefer it to be:








What do you consider to be the top three strengths of your neighborhood?


## Developing a Vision





## One potential idea...

Explore opportunities to leverage arts and culture to strengthen residents' sense of ownership of and connection to investments and activities at Cornerstone and along SE Hawthorne Road.

- Improve accessibility and connection between surrounding communities and Cornerstone site
- Signal that these **improvements** are for *current* residents of the neighborhood and East Gainesville
- Highlight and celebrate the cultural heritage and identities of surrounding communities
- Ensure that residents feel invited to and included in these spaces early, rather than as an afterthought

- Along SE 24th Street (Pine Meadows/Lake Terrace)
- Along SE 18th Street or SE 21st Street (Duval Heights)
- At Cornerstone
